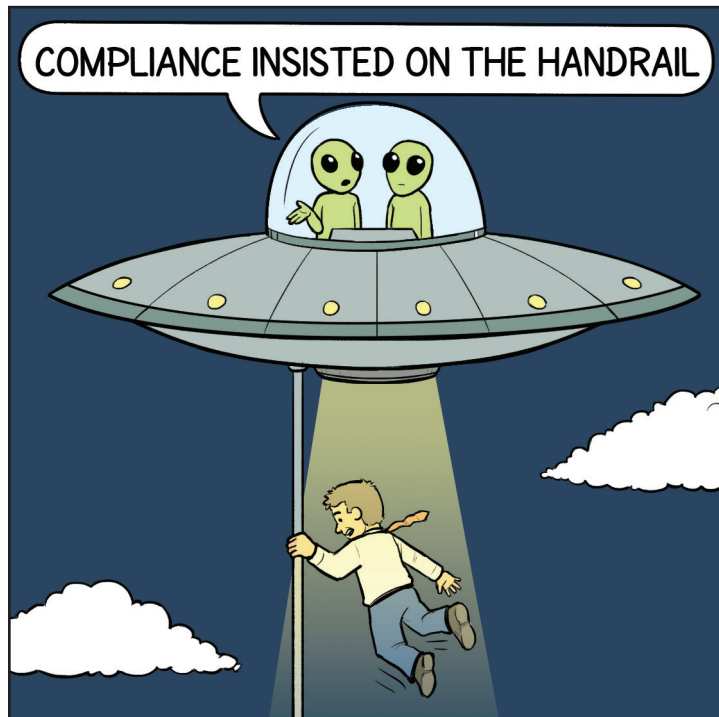
Hurt At Work: Do You Need A Lawyer?

In fact, construction workplace injuries account for more than one-third of all workplace deaths in New York City, despite employing a relatively small percentage of the workforce.

\$1,150,000 Secured for Injured Pedestrian

We recently secured a \$1,150,000 settlement on behalf of a pedestrian injured in a motor vehicle crash in Orange County, New York.

Our client, a Spanish-speaking individual, was struck by a vehicle making a left turn while crossing the street. The driver admitted she did not see him before the collision.

Through early investigation, our team secured Ring doorbell footage that clearly captured the crash and established fault. The only issue remaining was the extent of damages, which were severe.

Our client suffered multiple injuries, including a fractured clavicle and significant cervical spine damage that ultimately required a two-level cervical fusion surgery.

This type of surgery permanently alters spinal function and carries long-term consequences, including chronic pain, limited mobility, and the risk of future complications.

The case was resolved for \$1,150,000, paid by State Farm, reflecting the seriousness of the injuries, the strength of the evidence, and the lasting impact on our client's life.

Pedestrian accidents like this remain a serious and growing concern across New York. According to recent data from the New York State Department of Health, hundreds of pedestrians are killed each year statewide, with thousands more suffering serious injuries requiring hospitalization.

Cases involving serious injuries also highlight the importance of immediate investigation. Video evidence—such as residential security or doorbell footage—has become increasingly critical in establishing liability early and preventing disputes over fault. In this case, securing that footage helped position the claim for a strong resolution.
